JBL has introduced its new ES Series home theatre and stereo loudspeaker range which has seen a performance and design boost, the company says.

Successor to JBL's acclaimed Northridge E Series, JBL's ES Series uses technologies employed in the company's professional recording studio monitors and are available in two finishes.



The JBL ES Series includes six models: a compact bookshelf loudspeaker (ES20); three floorstanding tower speakers (ES80 and ES100); a dedicated centre channel loudspeaker (ES25C); and two powered subwoofers (ES150P and ES250P).

"To achieve their superlative performance, JBL incorporated a number of advanced technologies into the new ES Series" said Convoy Managing Director Alex McInnes.

"These included an ultrahigh-frequency transducer that provides extended frequency response to 40kHz, to deliver

open, smooth and detailed high-frequency reproduction with a more natural quality of spaciousness over a wide listening area."
